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Apple IOS

1 Navigate to **Settings** on your phone or Apple device.



2 Go to Wifi Settings.

3 Select SD6BYOD.



4 Type your SD6 username in the "Username" field.

5 Type your SD6 password in the "Password" field. Click **Join**.

6 When prompted, click Trust.





Andriod OS

1 Navigate to Settings on your phone or android device.



2 Go to Wifi Settings.

3 Select SD6BYOD.



4 Type your SD6 username in the "Identity" field.

5 Type your SD6 password in the "Password" field.

7 Click Don't Validate.



8 Click Connect.





Forget Network
